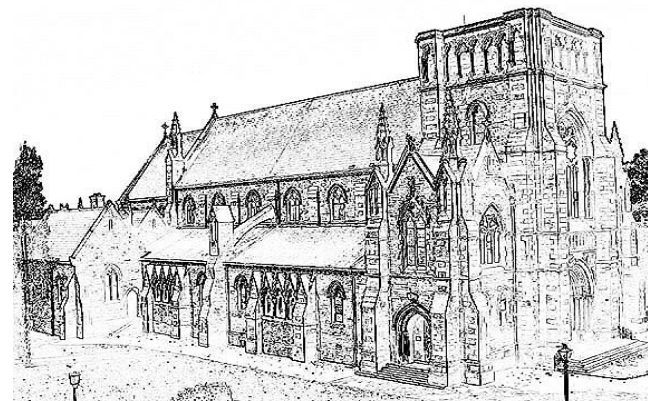

Diocesan Celebration to Inaugurate The Great Jubilee Year of Mercy

'Be merciful like the Father'

The Jubilee Year of Mercy will be inaugurated on 8 Dec 2015 and will run until 20 Nov 2016 – the solemnity of Christ the King. Bishop Freeman will inaugurate the Great Jubilee Year of Mercy in our diocese with the celebration of the Eucharist with priests, religious and the lay faithful, next Sunday, 13th, in St. Mary's Cathedral at 5.30 p.m. The beginning of the Jubilee Year is always solemnly marked by the opening of a Holy Door by the Pope in St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican. **Bishop Seamus, along with bishops throughout the world on that day in their dioceses, will officially open the Holy Door of Mercy, which is currently being prepared in St. Mary's Cathedral, the Mother Church of our diocese. All are invited and are most welcome.**
