Monsignor Dermot Farrell P.P. Dunboyne Bishop – Elect of Ossory

Monsignor Farrell was born in 1954 in the Parish of Castletown – Geoghegan, Co. Westmeath.

Educated at St. Finian's College Mullingar and studied for the Priesthood in St. Patrick's College, Maynooth ordained in 1980. He served as curate in Mullingar, Co. Westmeath for four years. He then went for further studies in Rome and was awarded a doctorate in Dogmatic Theology from the Gregorian University in 1988.

Following appointments in the Irish College in Rome and the parish of Tullamore, he was appointed to the teaching staff of St. Patrick's College, Maynooth in 1990. In 1993 he was appointed Vice-President of College and President from 1996 – 2007. 2007 – 2017 he was parish Priest of Dunboyne. Speaking in St. Mary's Cathedral on Wednesday, 3rd January 2018 following the announcement of his appointment he said: "Embracing this new role means that I will have a great deal to learn in the years ahead. It is going to take time. I will need the help and guidance of all the people of Ossory I would be grateful if you would remember me in your prayers as I begin my ministry as bishop, among you and with you.
