Ossory welcomes New Bishop

His Holiness Pope Francis has appointed Monsignor Dermot Pius Farrell, Parish Priest of Dunboyne & Kilbride in the Diocese of Meath, as the new Bishop of Ossory.

Monsignor Dermot Farrell

22 November 1954 Born, Castletown-Geoghegan Parish, Co Westmeath.

Baptised Dermot Pius a few days later in the Cathedral of Christ the King, Mullingar.

1959 – 1967 Primary Schools in Castletown-Geoghegan and Streamstown.

1967 – 1972 Post-Primary Education at Saint Finian's College (Diocesan Boarding School), Mullingar.

1972 – 1976 Bachelor of Science Degree at Saint Patrick's College, Maynooth.

1976 – 1979 Bachelor of Divinity Degree at Maynooth.

1979 – 1981 Licence in Theology Degree at Maynooth.

7 June 1980 Ordained priest for Diocese of Meath.

1981 – 1985 Curate, Cathedral Parish, Mullingar.

1985 – 1988 Doctorate Studies at Gregorian University, Rome.

1987 Director of Formation in Irish College, Rome.

1989 – 1990 Curate in Tullamore Parish and lecturer in Moral Theology at Maynooth.

1990 Appointed Executive Assistant to the President in Maynooth, continuing to lecture in Moral Theology.

1993 Appointed Vice-President of Saint Patrick's College, Maynooth.

1996 – 2007 President of Saint Patrick's College, Maynooth.

6 June 1997 Honorary Prelate of His Holiness.

2007 – presently Parish Priest of Dunboyne.

2009 Vicar General to the Diocese of Meath.

Bishop Farrell said that he was very grateful for the warm welcome he received and said he was looking forward to working closely with the people of Ossory over the coming years.
