Ferrybank CFR Group

We are a new voluntary, non profit group of Ferrybank residents with the aim of developing a community first responder programme within Ferrybank.

A Community First Responder is a person trained to a minimum basic level of basic life support in CPR and the use of an AED/defibrillator who attends to assist in an actual or potentially life threatening emergency such as a cardiac arrest, heart attack, stroke or choking. When a 999 call is placed every second counts !!! The time spent waiting until an ambulance and emergency personnel arrive is the critical time to try and assist in saving a life. A CFR group living within the community can arrive and initiate lifesaving steps until the ambulance arrives.

We are actively looking for volunteers within Ferrybank to come and train as Responders.

We would work in conjunction with the National ambulance service and respond when directed until the ambulance arrives. We plan to work on a roster basis with a minimum of 2 responders responding to a call. We will need a minimum number of volunteers to come forward in order to deliver this vital life saving service to Ferrybank.
