9th World Meeting of Families

The Holy Father Pope Francis happily will attend part of the 9th World Meeting of Families which will take place from 21 – 26 August in Dublin on the theme, 'The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World'.

Pope Francis, who is 81 years of age, will arrive in Dublin on Saturday, 25 August, and will take part in the 'Festival of Families' in Croke Park. The Festival of Families is the faith-based cultural concert of the World Meeting of Families six-day programme. The next day, Sunday 26 August, Pope Francis will be the chief celebrant at Holy Mass in the Phoenix Park and this liturgy will bring to a conclusion the World Meeting of Families 2018.

Archbishop Diarmuid Martin of Dublin, as President of the World Meeting of Families 2018, said "we eagerly await the visit of Pope Francis which no doubt will be an occasion of spiritual renewal for our laity, religious and clergy as well as a strengthening of Christian family life".

WMOF is an international celebration of faith bringing together a large number of Catholic families from across the globe to interact, pray and reflect on the central importance of marriage and the family as the cornerstone of our lives, of society and of the Church.
