‘Cultural Catholics rather than Catholics by Conviction’ (A quote from recent homily in Knock, by Bishop Leo O'Reilly, Kilmore on the recent decision of people in recent referendum)

“For the first time in my life we have had a nationwide mission of evangelisation led and carried out – not by bishops, priests or religious – but by lay people. A mission, not preached in churches, but rather in radio and TV studios, in hotels and homes, on doorsteps and streets. That is truly a quiet revolution.”

He said that while No campaigners may be disappointed with the referendum outcome, he urged them not to be.

“You will never know when the word you spoke on a doorstep about the value of human life will touch the heart of the hearer when they need to hear it. The important thing is that you sowed the seed. And that you keep sowing.”

The bishop said the role of lay people in the Church has taken “a decisive turn.”

I pray that this will be the beginning of a new phase in the Church’s mission of evangelisation... the campaign to protect the lives of unborn children in Ireland has not ended. It has only just begun.”
