The Memory Technology Resource Rooms are open every Wednesday in St. Columba’s Hospital Thomastown, Kilkenny and every Thursday in Sacred Heart Hospital, Carlow.

The Memory Technology Resource Rooms (MTRRS) are run by an Occupational Therapist and showcase a variety of assistive technology equipment. The MTRR is free to attend and provides people with memory difficulties and their carers the opportunity to see and discuss the benefits of assistive technology equipment.
