While it is estimated that as many as 7,000 people who had polio live in Ireland, many are not in touch with the charity Polio Survivors Ireland, making it difficult to lobby for improved services and support for those living with the impact of polio. The Register is being launched in Kilkenny this November; we are asking parishioners to help promote and support the Polio Register and also relay this information to polio survivors and their families.
